In this role, you will help organize existing events and develop new initiatives that generate donations, raise awareness, and build lasting relationships with donors and sponsors. The ideal candidate is a creative thinker, a proactive problem-solver, and has a passion for making a positive impact in healthcare.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborate with the Executive Director on the planning, execution, and evaluation of major fundraising events
- Collaborate events with local businesses
- Design and present tailored sponsorship packages for businesses, showcasing how their contributions support specific healthcare initiatives
- Utilize social media platforms (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) to promote events and drive attendance; designing promotional materials such as flyers, posters and email newsletters
- When needed, serve as the Foundation's representative at community meetings, business networking events, and health-related conferences
- Identify and engage with community influencers, healthcare workers, and civic leaders who can help expand the Foundation's reach
- Maintain a volunteer recruitment program for each event, ensuring volunteers are well-informed and supported throughout their involvement
- Collaborate with the Executive Director to create detailed budgets for events and fundraising campaigns, ensuring costs are tracked and managed effectively
